INTRODUCTION

- What makes you feel safe?
- · What makes you feel valued?

Day of the Lord(1 Thess. 5:1-11)

- · Where in the world are you tempted to find peace and security?
- Compare dark and light. What are dark things that you sometimes desire so much more than the light? How do you fight that?
- · What beliefs and behaviors are characteristic of each category?
- How does verse 8 compare to Ephesians 6:10-20?
- Explain how this verse brings attention back to 1 Thess. 1:3.

Parting Instructions (1 Thess. 5:12-28)

- How many times does Paul use the address "brothers"? What does this tell you?
 - Note: the greek word translated at "brothers" is used to refer to all believers, male or female, and is translated as "brothers and sisters" in the CSB.
- What happens when the "among you" begins to drown out the "over you"? What about the reverse? (ESV)
- What is one way you can begin to respect and esteem your church leaders more intentionally?
- Which of the three commands in v.16-18 challenges you the most?
- Look at verse 23-24. Explain spirit, soul, and body and how to keep each blameless.

APPLICATION

Keep awake and be sober. Fight. Respect. Admonish. Press into sanctification; it is a painful but necessary process.
