INTRODUCTION

Paul shared how salvation came for both the Jews and the Gentiles which painted the picture of a beautiful diverse church. While the Church (all Christians) is diverse, it must also be unified. Paul writes here not to discourage what everyone uniquely brings to the table, but keep everyone and all of their gifts working together towards the same goal – to build maturity in Christ.

Read Ephesians 4: 1 - 16

1. Unity in all things – what's the purpose

- What does Paul encourage to make every effort to do? Why do you think this was so important (keeping in mind last Ephesian's Bible Study)?
- Why do you think Paul draws out all of the oneness in verses 4 6? our faith is full of unity amongst diversity – 3 persons one God, Jesus (one man) had two natures, etc. there is a beautiful oneness to follow
- What will the church accomplish by being unified? verses 13 and 15 maturity
- Scripture says that we will do this by speaking the truth in love (v 15) what does that mean to you?
- We work together as different parts of the body, but it's important to keep Christ at the head. What happens if we don't?

2. Different Gifts - how do we do this?

- In verse 11 who did Jesus give? (leaders with different jobs) and who did He give them to? (The Church). For what purpose?
- Do you know the roles as described in verse 11? Apostles, Prophets, Evangelists, Pastors, Teachers
- What gifts and talents do you feel like God has specifically given to you?
- Do you feel like you use these to help those around you grow in maturity for Christ?

What is one way you can go out of your way use your gift to help someone around you this week?
